Irish Medical Council accreditation to Perdana U

ALL university and college courses are inspected by regulatory bodies to ensure that the courses meet certain established standards.

Last month (April), the Irish Medical Council awarded a full accreditation to the Perdana University-Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland (School of Medicine) (PU-RCSI) Medical Degree Programme.

This means that the programme meets the necessary standards for recognition.

The programme is conducted wholly in Malaysia with close collaboration between the RCSI and Perdana University.

This five-year programme leads to the award of the Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery and Bachelor in the Art of Obstetrics (MBBChBAO) by the National University of Ireland.

The curriculum is identical to the one in Ireland.

The programme is conducted wholly in Malaysia with close collaboration between the RCSI and Perdana University.
