

Complete an Irish medical qualification entirely in Malaysia

PERDANA University is the only private higher education institution in Malaysia to offer the 5+0 medical degree programme in collaboration with the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland (RCSI).

This enables financial savings and peace of mind for families as it enables students to complete an Irish medical qualification in its entirety in Malaysia.

The programme is recognised by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency, the Malaysian Medical Council and the Irish Medical Council, enabling graduates to practise medicine anywhere in the world.

The five-year curriculum is divided into three cycles: Junior Cycle, Intermediate Cycle and Senior Cycle.

With the study of biomedical science, clinical medicine, clinical competency and Community and International Health, students are imbued with an understanding of knowledge, attitudes and skills that helps develop them personally and professionally to serve as medical doctors in the community.

At Perdana University, the quality of education is assured as students are provided with the same programme with a large teaching team of academicians from RCSI.

Its laboratories are well equipped and meet the standards of RCSI and include an anatomy museum, clinical skill unit, anatomy laboratory, multi-disciplinary laboratory and computer laboratory.

Students have access to well-stocked libraries at the university and can also access the online library of RCSI.

Upon fulfilling all criteria, graduates obtain two award titles:

- > Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery and Bachelor of the Art of Obstetrics (MB BCh BAO) of the National University of Ireland.

- > Licentiate LRCP and SCI of the Royal College of Physicians of Ireland and Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland.

To enable students to achieve their ambition to be medical doctors, there is a wide range of scholarships and financial aids from Perdana University and others such as the Public Services Department (PSD) / Jabatan Perkhidmatan Awam (JPA) Scholarship or the Perbadanan Tabung Pendidikan Tinggi Nasional (PTPTN).

Perdana University was established as a Public Private Partnership (PPP) initiative by Academic Medical Centre Sdn Bhd, a

subsidiary of Chase Perdana Sdn Bhd with the support of the Unit Kerjasama Awam Swasta of the Prime Minister's Department.

The university is envisioned to be an education-research hub for the region to fulfil the needs of the nation for competent health science graduates.

It operates from an interim campus that is well furnished in the Malaysia Agro Exposition Park Serdang, a short drive to the townships of Serdang, Sri Kembangan and Putrajaya as well as IOI City Mall.
